<b>Deeds</b> Prepared for transfer of real estate into Revocable Trusts, Full title examination is a separate additional fee. Client must provide documentation for attorney.	<b>\$200</b>
<b>Probate</b> Preparation of an Informal or Formal Probate Procedure, Quoted on a case by case basis after initial consultation. Minimum retainer of \$2500.	<b>\$300 / hour</b>
<b>Other Probate and Estate Planning Services</b> Specialized products and services such as testamentary or special needs trusts, codicil to will or amendment to trust vary in cost to be determined after phone consultation.	<b>Varies</b>
